I. General Responsibilities

The term of each member shall be for one year

The Junior Board meets over Zoom 4 times per year for approximately 1 hr
- B. Become informed and educated about Mwana and the industry of which it is a part

II. Fundraising Responsibilities

III. Public Relations Responsibilities

- A. Be an enthusiastic advocate for the mission of Mwana Villages

- C. For College students: connect us with your campus pastor
- D. For professionals: connect us with one business or individual who might be interested in partnership
