Pray for the Congolese courts. Pray for true justice to reign. Pray against corruption, Pray for diligence in processing cases for Mwana Villages children and families. Pray for more cohorts to come alongside God's faithful servants who are working in the Congolese legal system. Pray for their protection and wisdom as they serve God in those places, shining His light in the darkness.

TUESDAY

Pray for physical, emotional, and spiritual healing for the Mwana Villages children and vulnerable families. Pray for wisdom and provision to care for the medical needs of children living with disabilities, fragile medical statuses, or chronic illnesses.

Pray for protection for vulnerable children and families in Congo. Pray against human trafficking. Pray against enslavement and prostitution. Pray for protection of the staff, families, and children of Mwana Villages. Pray for physical and spiritual safety.

THURSDAY

Pray for freedom for the captives. Pray for those children caught in complicated court cases or devastating child welfare cases that prevent them from being placed with a forever family. Pray for the vulnerable people of Congo caught in addiction or slavery. Pray for the abandoned sick babies stuck at the hospitals needing nourishment, skilled nursing care, and nurturing. Pray for a holy jailbreak.

"Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty [emancipation from bondage, true freedom]." 2 Corinthians 3:17 AMP

"The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed and commissioned me to bring good news to the humble and afflicted; He has sent me to bind up [the wounds of] the brokenhearted, to proclaim release [from confinement and condemnation] to the [physical and spiritual] captives and freedom to prisoners;" Isaiah 61:1 AMP

FRIDAY

Pray for the future of Mwana Villages. Pray for vision, unity, wisdom, and discernment for the staff and board to hear and know the direction of the Lord. Pray for others to rise up and join the mission to love the vulnerable people of Congo in the name of Jesus. Pray for human resources and financial resources to move forward. Pray that the people of Mwana Villages neither run ahead nor lag behind where God is leading. Pray for strength and courage.

"For we are His workmanship [His own master work, a work of art], created in Christ Jesus [reborn from above--spiritually transformed, renewed, ready to be used] for good works, which God prepared [for us] beforehand [taking paths which He set], so that we would walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us]."
